Please find below details for the above trip.

The coaches will be departing from the school at 7:45am and we would ask, therefore, that students arrive at school for 7:30am and go straight to the Sports Hall to register. It is anticipated that we will return to school no later than 6:00pm, (please make sure you have your own arrangements in place to ensure students travel home safely at that time).

Students are not required to wear school uniform. They should wear appropriate clothing for the outdoor activities and suitable footwear. For activities with water, students need to have an old pair of trainers or water shoes and take a change of clothes and a towel. There are showers if needed. Students are also required to bring a packed lunch and a drink.

In the likelihood that it is a warm sunny day, please ensure that your son/daughter has sun cream and a hat to wear. Please also ensure that they have a raincoat in the event that it rains.

If you have not yet sent back the medical/consent form, this needs to be handed to Student Services as soon as possible. Also if you have not paid the balance, this needs to be paid immediately. Failure to pay the balance or provide the medical/consent will unfortunately result in your son/daughter not being able to go on the trip. By returning the medical/consent form signed, you agree to your son/daughter taking part in this trip and the activities.

The school reserves the right to withdraw this offer where there is reason to suggest that a student's participation may prejudice the safety or good conduct of the trip. Should the school cancel the visit/event for any reason; a full refund will be made. However, all monies are non-refundable if you cancel the place.
