RE: THREE DAY ACTIVITY PROGRAMME – MONDAY 10TH JULY TO WEDNESDAY 12TH JULY 2017

In an effort to enhance the school's extra-curricular timetable, each year group will be "off timetable" from Monday 10th July to Wednesday 12th July. During these days, students will participate in a variety of sessions with their year group. The Spanish department's GCSE trip coincides with these dates so those studying Spanish will not be able to take part in these three days of activities.

The Year 10 programme will be as follows:

Day 1 (Monday 10th July) – Focus on the Core Subjects, English, Maths and Science

To help students with English GCSE studies, "Shakespeare Rewired" will be coming in to show students a production of "Macbeth." This will be followed by a workshop to help pull out some of the key features of the text. We also have a mobile planetarium coming in to give pupils an interactive revision session on some of the Science topics covered this year. These interactive sessions will compliment some focused Maths activities later in the day.

Day 2 (Tuesday 11th July) – Wellbeing Challenge Day

We value the education of our students' wellbeing, as well as their academic education, therefore, day two of the programme will be focused on online safety, mental wellbeing and ways to help manage these. This will be delivered through a combination of classroom learning and a guest presentation. Students will be working in groups throughout the day to produce an awareness campaign. They may be using a range of school resources such as the green screen in media, or be involved in recording a radio broadcast to be aired or producing a piece of art or a drama production for local schools.

Day 3 (Wednesday 12th July) – It's a Knockout

July 2017 marks the end of their final full year with their whole year group. We would therefore like all students to spend the third day celebrating and making memories with the rest of the year group and their tutors. Students will be taking part in an inter-house "It's a Knockout Challenge". They will compete against other teams to complete seven different games which may include inflatables, water and foam. In the afternoon, all forms will be with their tutors for a form party celebration including activities decided by the tutor and tutees.

The cost of all activities over the course of the three days will be £23.00. Cash/cheque payments should be returned to Student Services by 21st April 2017 along with the reply slip below. If making your payment by Parent Pay, please write the reference number on the reply slip before returning it to Student Services.

Specific details of what to wear or bring into school will be sent home nearer the time. All students are encouraged to participate in these enrichment days. Should your son/daughter not wish to participate in the activities, they will still be expected to be in school and an alternative provision will be provided for them.
